II. Purpose of Addendum

A request to modify the capacity of the day camp and day campsite was received on 2/12/21 by letter. The licensed capacity was listed at 30 campers. The recreation supervisor requested to increase the licensed capacity to 70 campers.

III. Methodology

An onsite inspection was completed with a review of the available indoor space, outdoor space, and toilet facilities.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The campsite is Buhr Park. The 39-acre park includes a large sheltered pavilion, outdoor swimming pool, locker rooms including toilet facilities, ball fields, and open green space.

V. Recommendation

I recommend an increase of licensed capacity to 70 campers.
